



# Above Ground Drainage and Rainwater Systems

Assessment Information	Designed to give installers the skills and knowledge required to correctly install Above Ground Drainage and Rainwater Systems, this course consists of a training/reference manual to be read before a 1-day training session and completion of a written assessment.
Pre-requisites	Trainees should have an S/NVQ Level 2/3 qualification in plumbing or a demonstrable number of years of relevant experience. However, this course is also suitable for students working towards a S/NVQ Level 2/3.
Further Information	Assessments normally consist of a theory examination. This training course is also a method of proving operative competence in sanitary and rainwater pipework systems under the requirements of Building regulations competent person Schemes e.g. APHC (Certification) Ltd CP Scheme
Expiry Information	Certificates are normally valid for 5 years.
Useful Information	It is designed to ensure that installers are fully aware of the legislation surrounding the design and installation requirements of both above ground sanitary and rainwater systems and also the purpose and use of the various components within each system including macerators and waste disposal systems.
